We invite you to join us at our upcoming PTO meetings every 2nd Monday of the month where we will discuss important topics such as school


events, fundraising efforts, and more. Your input and insights are invaluable in shaping

PROJECT RESILIENCE

Project Resilience welcomes you back to after-school on August 15th on-site at Rio Del Oro Elementary and Cobblestone Elementary. Enrolled students in 6th grade will be bused to Rio Del Oro Elementary from Riverside Middle School. All enrollments for the 2024-2025 school year have been confirmed. If you have not received an enrollment confirmation email and completed the needs assessment, your child has been placed on the waitlist for the 2024-2025 school year. Project Resilience after-school educators will be on-site to welcome students in TK and Kindergarten at 12:00 p.m. on August 15th and 16th. If you have a child in TK or Kindergarten, they can start 8/15 or 8/19. Each

afternoon, we welcome students in 1st-6th grade directly after school in the cafeteria and escort students in TK and K directly from their classrooms.

DROP OFF AND PICK UP

The Yuba County Sheriff's Department and PLESD school officials work closely to plan for the safe arrival and departure of students at our campus. We are asking for your support and help in the safe loading and unloading of children at Rio Del Oro Elementary School.

- 1. Assist us in teaching your child to use the crosswalks coming to school and leaving campus. Teach her/him to walk, not run, through the crosswalk.
- 2. Do not stop in the crosswalk to deliver or pick up your child. California State law prohibits stopping in a designated crosswalk, this constitutes a moving violation.

- 3. Do not leave your vehicle unattended in the drop off/pick up lane in front of the cafeteria, front office and Kindergarten buildings. Parents must park in a designated parking space in the parking lot if they plan to leave their vehicle.
- 4. Cars in the drop off/pick up lane must pull forward as far as possible and may be asked to loop back around to allow other cars to leave.
- 5. Thank you in advance for showing **patience and courtesy** so that all our students are safe!
